

Program Requirement

Minors(15 –17 years old) do not need a learner’s permit to attend classes; however, they will need it to perform behind the wheel driving (BTW).

The State of Hawaii law states that the program, which includes 30 hours of classroom and 6 hours of BTW (behind-the-wheel) instruction, cannot be completed in less than 6 weeks. At the completion of the 30 hours of classroom training, the student will receive a Certificate of Completion card (yellow).

The scheduled classroom meeting dates do not include BTW (behind-the-wheel) instruction. We recommend the student schedule a BTW instructor after the second classroom meeting but if they have already started to drive prior, that’s fine too. Names will be provided at the start of class.

A written practice driving log listing a description of a minimum of 40 hours of daytime and 10 hours of night time practice driving must be listed on the provided log sheet. When completed, the log must be notarized and turned in to the BTW instructor in exchange for the behind-the-wheel completion certificate (blue). This is the final step before taking a road test. This certificate along with the classroom completion certificate (yellow) will need to be presented to the examiner at the time of the road test along with documents needed by the DOT (Department of Transportation).

LOST COMPLETION CERTIFICATES

There shall be a \$25.00 charge to replace a lost Classroom Certificate of Completion.
